- Founded in 1971 and still privately-held, WinnCompanies is an award-winning owner, developer and manager of high-impact, quality apartment homes.
- We manage more than 109,000 apartment homes across 700 communities in 25 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico.
- Ranked as the largest manager of affordable housing, the second-largest manager of privatized military housing, and one of the largest managers of all rental housing in the US.
- Our Housing Stability Program has supported 60,000 households in avoiding eviction.
- Proud developer and owner of 130 communities in 12 states and the District of Columbia.
- **4,000 dedicated team members** and growing, with minority team members holding 52% of managerial positions.

WinnResidential

WinnResidential operates low-income, affordable, mixed-income, and marketrate communities in **16 states and the District of Columbia**, consistently ranking as the nation's largest affordable housing manager.



WinnDevelopment leads new construction and rehab activities to deliver thoughtful, mixed-income communities, focusing on affordable and workforce housing, with **more than 25,000 units** created and preserved.



WinnResidential Military Housing Service, a joint venture with Lendlease, manages **25 communities** providing nearly **41,300 homes** for U.S. Armed Forces members and their families in **17 states** and **Puerto Rico**.









WinnDevelopment

- WinnDevelopment has acquired and developed more than 25,000 units at 130 communities over the past 53 years, focusing on large-scale mixed-use development, historic adaptive reuse, and undervalued multifamily housing.
- With offices in Boston, New York, and Washington D.C., the 50-person team supports a robust pipeline of projects in 12 states and the District of Columbia.
- As a trusted leader in high-performance development, we've invested over \$60 million in energy and water conservation projects by deploying energy efficiency, carbon planning, and renewable energy projects portfolio-wide.
- An award-winning national leader in the adaptive reuse of historic properties, WinnDevelopment has transformed 44 vacant properties in the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast into nearly 5,300 mixed-income homes.
- Since 2015 alone, we've completed over 28 occupied rehabilitation projects in six states and the District of Columbia, with total development costs exceeding \$670 million. Currently 600 units are under renovation portfolio-wide.
- WinnDevelopment is also a champion and creator of middle-income housing, having developed 300+ such units in the past six years in MA, NY, and NJ communities, with 80 more under construction.

APPROACH TO DECARBONIZATION

- WinnCompanies has an in-house Energy and Sustainability department that oversees a broad range of sustainability initiatives for the Winn owned portfolio.
- WinnCompanies is integrating decarbonization objectives in all rehab and new construction projects, investing in exterior envelope retrofits, utilizing design standards such as passive house, and deploying high-efficiency heat pump technologies to eliminate or reduce fossil fuel use.
- While decarbonization in existing, occupied multifamily buildings continues to be technically and financially challenging, the Empire Building Challenge is a pivotal opportunity for WinnCompanies to collaborate with NYSERDA and their partners to evaluate and develop optimal decarbonization solutions that are both resource efficient and scalable.











SUSTAINABILITY TRACK RECORD

- Since 2009, WinnCompanies, and its affiliate, Open Market ESCO (OME), have audited over 10,000 multifamily housing units and implemented more than \$60 million in energy and water conservation projects across Winn's portfolio, while participating in the below high-impact and innovative state and federal initiatives:

- Winn's new construction, rehab, and historic adaptive reuse pipeline consists of several high-performance projects pursuing certification programs such as: Enterprise Green Communities, LEED, Energy Star, Zero Energy Ready Homes, and Passive House.
- Winn is a committed Better Buildings Challenge and Better Climate Challenge Partner.
- Carbon Neutrality Definition: Super efficient, low-energy fossil fuel free building that focuses on passive principles and highly-efficient space heating and cooling systems, offering a pathway to net-zero emissions.



EBC COMMITMENT: STOVROFF TOWERS

- Built in 2003, Stovroff Towers is an existing 4-story senior living facility located in Amherst, NY, comprised of 120 studio apartments.
- Mechanical System Description:
 - Heating: Natural Gas, Forced air furnaces with gas-fired heat
 - Cooling: Packaged AC
 - Distribution: Heating and cooling is unitized, with every 2 apartments sharing 1 gas furnace
 - Other:
 - Common area heat: Gas-fired hot water boiler provides heat to perimeter baseboard registers throughout common areas.
 - o DHW: Two gas-fired hot water boilers and two 119-gallon, insulated storage tanks supply domestic hot water
- Exterior Façade Description:
 - Concrete block and aluminum-framed curtain wall systems, with 1" insulated glass
