Appendix C. Billing Analysis Fit Summary

The billing analysis modeling process has two stages. The first occurs at the site level for the pre- and post-installation periods. This modeling is changepoint modeling to facilitate weather normalizing all consumption to TMY weather. These models locate and correlate between load and degree days, cumulative temperatures above and below assigned base temperatures. These models identify portions of consumption that are correlated with either heating degree days or cooling degree days and allow just those portions of consumption to be adjusted to reflect those TMY temperatures.

The figures below provide a histogram for the r-squared values for the models for gas and electric. The pre- and postimplementation models for participants and comparison group customers are grouped into r-square bins. For gas, where the correlation of heating consumption is strong and there are limited other end-uses, the majority of the models have R-square above 90%. For electric, there are more models that explain a more limited degree of variation, as is typical. This is to be expected because in NY not all households will have strong heating or cooling correlations. Importantly, the distribution of rsquare across the two time periods and two groups are roughly similar within each r-square bin. For electric, the portion of consumption that is weather correlated is low compared to gas so the possibility for error entering through the weather normalization process is also limited.

The second stage of the billing analysis compares the difference between pre- and post-installation consumption for the participant and comparison groups in a difference in difference (DID) framework. The DID framework means that any shortcomings in site-level modeling will be balanced out across the timeframes and groups. The calculations of precisions for the final impact estimates take into consideration the residual error of the site-level models via the across site aggregation process. For this billing analysis, the sources of error from the site-level models are limited and the DID structure addresses any error that is present explicitly.
